As a member of the Mid-Coast Industry Education Alliance – a cooperative of

local businesses, schools and colleges – STP was instrumental in developing the Nuclear Power Technology Degree Program, recently certified by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board. As a part of this initiative, STP helped

Bay City acquire a dilapidated former “big box” retail store and transform it into a beautiful satellite campus and office building. STP occupies one side of the 80,000-square-foot facility, while Wharton County Junior College holds classes on the other.

STP also created an Educational Incentive Program that pays tuition and book expenses for as many as 60 students a year while they earn the new Nuclear Power Technology degree. Students who graduate with this degree qualify for a well-paid job, right at STP.

Because of STP, young people now have the best opportunity in Matagorda County's 150-year history to launch an outstanding career...right at home. This keeps families together, keeps our community intact, and keeps our future possibilities...limitless.
