

## STP Nuclear Operating Company Declares Notification of Unusual Event

**Wadsworth, Texas** — Oct. 13, 2025 — 11:05 p.m.

STP Nuclear Operating Company (STPNOC) declared a Notification of Unusual Event (NOUE) today after being notified by the Matagorda County Sheriff's Office of a potential security concern related to the site.

The threat has not been substantiated. Site officials are working closely with Matagorda County officials to ensure the continued safety and security of the facility and its employees.

A Notification of Unusual Event is the lowest of four emergency classifications used by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). It indicates a situation that poses no threat to public health or safety and typically requires no action by the public.

Nuclear power plants are among the most secure and hardened facilities in the nation, protected by highly trained, armed security officers who undergo continuous training and evaluation to maintain readiness and ensure the safety and security of the plant.

## **South Texas Project**

The South Texas Project Electric Generating Station is a two-unit nuclear power plant located in Matagorda County, approximately eight miles west of Wadsworth. The company's two units produce 2,700 megawatts of carbon-free energy. The plant is managed by the STP Nuclear Operating Company and owned by Constellation Energy Generation, CPS Energy and Austin Energy.
